**Our course: Brush-up online course: English language and Methodology**

The aim of the course is to update teachers about new developments in the English language and provide some tips on teaching practice to improve teachers' confidence in using and teaching English.

Topics that will be covered are:

The course will include 6 webinars and 5 weeks of individual study and interaction with other course participants through forum discussions, quizzes, variety of activities, and quizzes. It will run from 20th January to the beginning of March 2022.

**Cost = free**

**Platform: Zoom** (for the synchronous content)

**iTeach platform and Google Drive** (for asynchronous content)

**Certificate awarded upon completion (minimum 80%)**

The course runs from Thursday to Wednesday every week. This will give course participants time to work on the lessons at the weekend.

Each week starts with a webinar on Thursday evening 19.00-20.00 Macedonian time (18.00-19.00 UK time). Webinars will be recorded and the recording will be available to all course participants for future reference.

Each week will include a variety of assignments to cover around 2.5 hours of self study such as reading, watching videos, and reflecting. Participants will be asked to make connections with their own teaching context where appropriate.

The course is designed for teachers with a B2+/C1 level of English.

80% participation is required to receive a certificate.
